

Year 3 Medium Term Plan Autumn 1

Maths

- Recognise the place value of each digit in a three-digit number (hundreds, tens, ones).
- Compare and order numbers up to 1000.
- Read and write numbers up to 1000 in numerals and in words.
- Identify, represent and estimate numbers using different representations.
- Add and subtract numbers mentally.
- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

English

- Use the correct form of 'a' or 'an'.
- Increase the legibility, consistency and quality of handwriting.
- Plan their writing by: discussing and recording ideas.
- Write compound sentences using coordinating conjunctions.
- Prepare poems and play scripts to read aloud and to perform, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action.
- Use the first two or three letters of a word to check its spelling in a dictionary.

History – Ancient Egypt

- Use dates and vocabulary relating to the passing of time, including ancient, modern, century and decade, AD and BC.
- Examine and compare artefacts.
- Explain the achievements of ancient civilizations and their impact on the world in the past and today.
- Knows that the past can be divided into different periods of time.

Science – Rocks, soils and fossils

- Compare and group together different kinds of rocks on the basis of their appearance and simple physical properties.
- Recognise that soils are made from rocks and organic matter.
- Describe in simple terms how fossils are formed when things that have lived are trapped within rock.

Art and DT

- Select from and use a wider range of tools and equipment to perform practical tasks accurately.
- Improve their mastery of art and design techniques, including drawing and painting, using a range of materials.

RE

- Make links between values and commitments, and own attitudes and behaviour.
- Respond to questions that cause wonder, staying respectful to others' beliefs and ideas.
