Literacy

Reading – We will develop our knowledge of inferring and making predictions about a text and discuss an authors' use of language through group reading.

Writing – During this half term we will be developing our explanation skills about natural disasters and letter writing skills, writing letters to Santa.

We will be focusing on securing the essential skills to write effectively including capital letter, full stops and finger spaces.

Mathematics

Number/Calculation – We will be developing our understanding of place value, becoming secure with tens and ones.

We will be ordering numbers and using our knowledge of the terms 'greater than', 'less than' and 'equals' to compare numbers.

Measure/Time

We will be learning about days of the week, months of the year and telling time including quarter past/to.

Fractions.

We will begin to look at fractions of shapes, being secure up to quarters.

D&T / Art

We will be designing and making a working, erupting volcano!

Science

During Science we will be exploring the changing seasons and comparing the differences we can notice through each season.

Religious Education

During this term we will be looking at the story and meaning of Christmas and how people celebrate in their own homes.

Geography

To run alongside our natural disasters topic, we will be learning more about the different continents and oceans of the world and finding out where major natural disasters have and are most likely to occur.
